Join Biscuit on his first family trip!

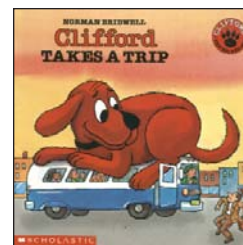


Blueberries for Sal

Sal goes on a blueberry-picking adventure!

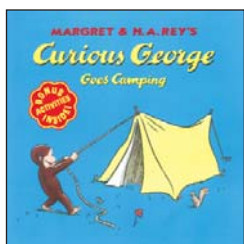


Clifford Takes a Trip

Clifford can't go on vacation with Emily Elizabeth. Or can he?

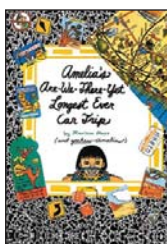


Curious George Goes Camping

Amelia and her big sister are stuck together in the car for a family road trip.

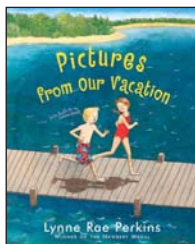


How I Spent My Summer Vacation

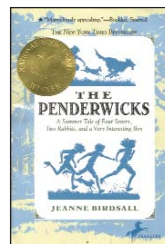


Vacation Under the Volcano

Jack and Annie go to Pompeii to bring back an ancient story.

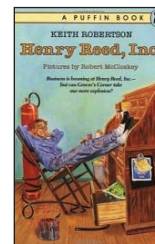


The Penderwicks
