



# How We Simplified ROR Data Collection Using EMR

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## Before EMR

- The ROR Coordinator created book slips, with the name of the book, age group and inserted them in each book
- The provider writes the date, age of the child, and their name on the slip
- Slip is then inserted in a box on the provider's desk
- The Slips are manually tallied at the end of the month

# Using EMR

- Click added to the Well child visit templates
  - 6-9mos, 12-15mos, 18-24mos, 25-36mos, and 4-5 yrs
- Provider click in Anticipatory Guidance, ROR Book given
- Access to reports when needed
